



Dear Mr. Denise:

This letter provides Kansas Gas and Electric Company's (KG&E) response to your letter of February 19, 1985, which transmitted Inspection Report STN 50-482/84-56. As requested, this response identifies the program that addresses the corrective action taken by KG&E to address the specific comments and the generic issues identified in the Inspection Report.

Inspector Followup Item 84/56-01:

The specific comments on procedures identified in the report have been reviewed by the Wolf Creek Staff. Those procedures required for Mode 6 have been revised to address the comments. The remaining procedures have been classified by Mode restraint and will be revised prior to their required use.

All future procedure refinements will incorporate the specific issues as well as the generic issues identified in this Inspection Report. This will be accomplished during the review of completed procedures by the individual assigned the review function for each procedure type.

Procedure ADM 01-050, "WCGS Operational Phase Verification Program", has been issued to identify operational phase verification activities. This procedure provides the one direction which defines, on the station level, the requirements for independent verification.

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
