You responded to this issue in a letter dated January 18, 1985. In your letter you provided a report of laboratory testing of painted cement and steel samples taken from inside containment. Actual containment spray water was used in an autoclave. Post test inspection indicates that there is adequate adhesion of the coating materials. In addition you have proposed an inspection program to assure that coatings do not deteriorate to conditions less favorable than the actual samples used.

The staff concludes that the laboratory tests and proposed periodic testing is adequate subject to confirmation by the resident inspector.
