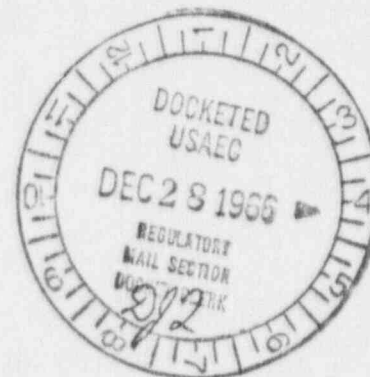
Both of these Endorsements are effective January 1, 1967.

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(SUPPL)CHANGES IN SUBSCRIBING COMPANIES
AND IN THEIR PROPORTIONATE LIABILITY ENDORSEMENT

It is agreed that with respect to bodily injury or property damage caused, during the effective period of this endorsement, by the nuclear energy hazard:

1. The word "companies" wherever used in the policy means the subscribing companies listed below.
2. The policy shall be binding on such companies only.
3. Each such company shall be liable only for its below-designated proportion of any obligation assumed or expense incurred under the policy because of such bodily injury or property damage.
4. The effective period of this endorsement is from the beginning of January 1, 1967, to the close of December 31, 1967, or to the time of the termination or cancellation of the policy, if sooner.


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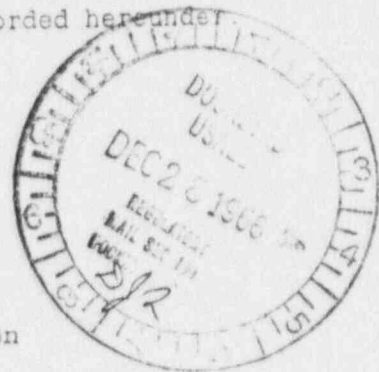
