SUMMARY

Scope:

This routine, unannounced inspection was conducted in the areas of Physical Barriers, Intrusion Detection Alarms, Communication, Contingency Operations, Compensatory Measures, Access Control (Personnel and Vehicles), Alarm Stations, Lighting, Security Force Annual Audit, and Training and Qualification.

Results:

In the areas inspected, violations or deviations were not identified. The licensee continues to provide strong support for the security programs, audits were a strength, as well as the continued maintenance support to re-construct equipment to pre-Hurricane Andrew conditions. Two licensee initiated drills were observed and in both drills the on duty security force was capable of responding to the contingency and neutralized the situation. The inspector noted, while conducting lighting surveys, that in some areas the projected area lighting was less than 0.2 footcandles but in compliance with the commitments of the Physical Security Plan.

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
