This refers to the inspection conducted by F. N. Wright of this office on November 2-6, 1992. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your Crystal River facility. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified.

Your attention is directed to the exercise weaknesses identified in Paragraphs 7 and 12 of the enclosed Inspection Report. As required by 10 CFR 50, Appendix E, Section IV.F, any weaknesses that are identified shall be corrected. Accordingly, please advise us within 45 days of the date of this letter, the corrective action you have taken, or plan to take, showing the estimated date of completion with regards to exercises weakness.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
