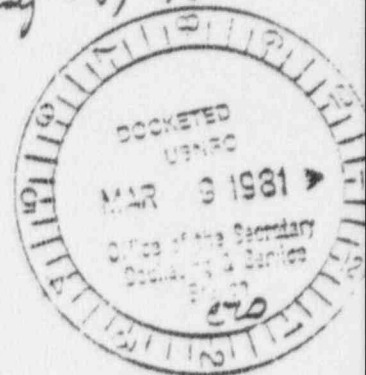

Gentlemen:

The Three Mile Island "incident" was a technological disaster of unprecedented seriousness.

I do not believe that the operation should be allowed to resume. I do not believe that the "clean-up" has proceeded in a proper manner. Economic pressures seem to over-ride the public interests which should, in my opinion, require the ~~minimum~~ minimum exposure to ~~radioactive~~ radioactive contamination.

It seems to me that the Commission must resist the economic pressures of the utilities regardless of short term financial distress - a distress that should, in our society, be fully borne by the utility and its investors.

Please protect the public health by refusing to allow restarting of any of the units.
