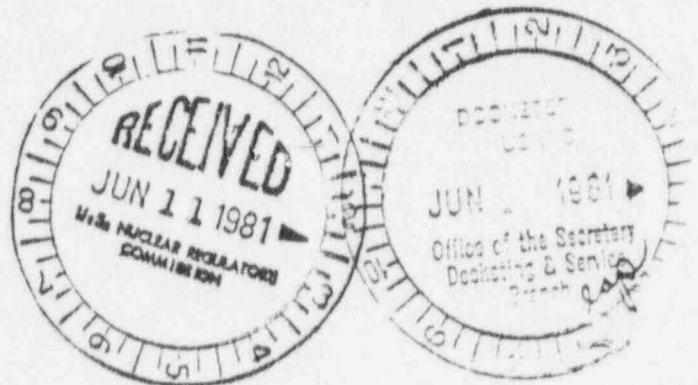
Dear NRC:

I'm a concerned person living in the immediate area of the Humboldt Bay Nuclear Power Plant. I would like the plant to be permanently closed: decommissioned.
