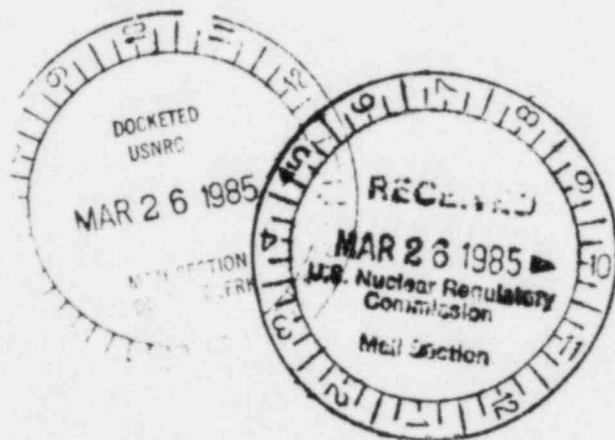

Gentlemen:

On January 28, 1985 Plateau submitted to your office for review organizational changes which effected the reporting responsibility of the Environmental and Radiological Health Supervisor ("ERHS") at the Shooting Canyon Uranium Processing Facility. The ERHS also serves as the Radiation Safety Officer for Plateau's Blanding Ore Buying Station. 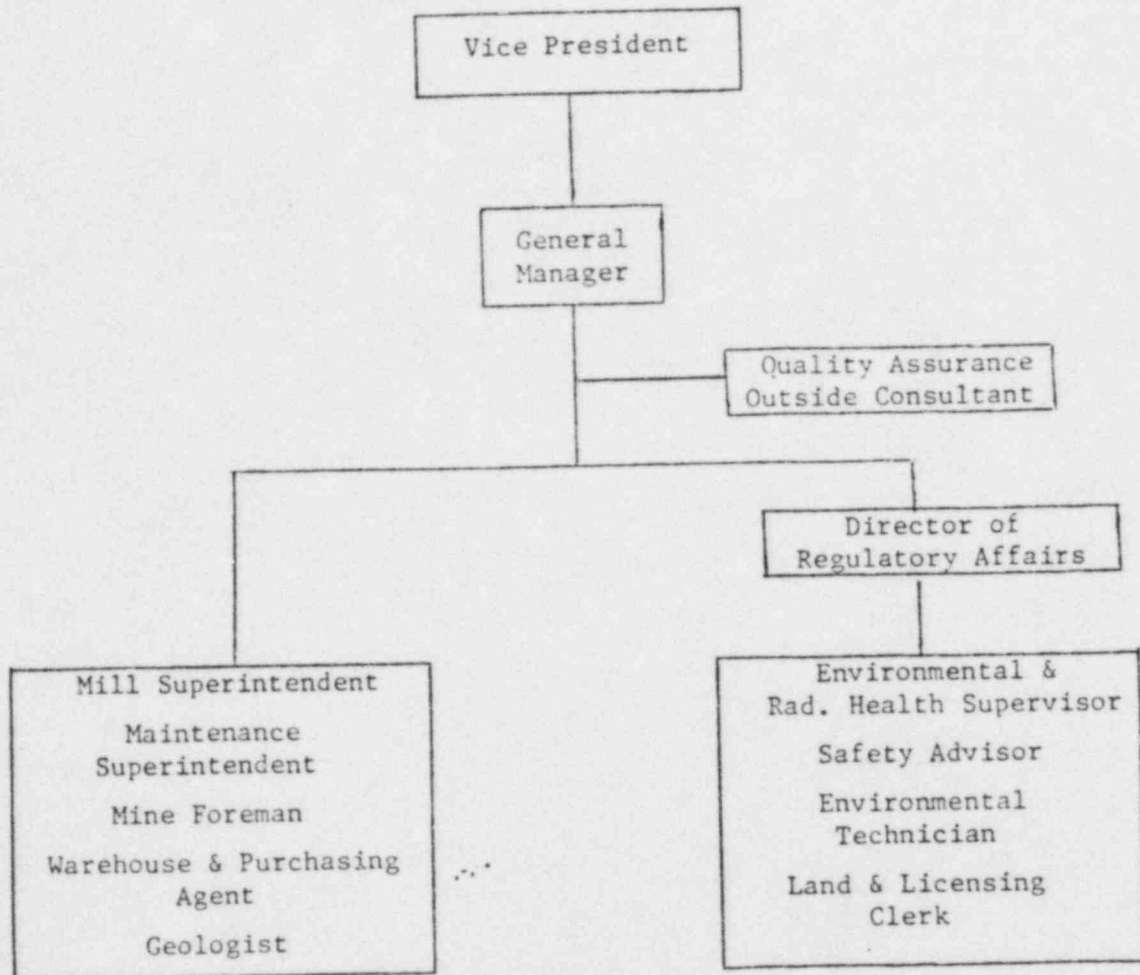
