Gentlemen:

This acknowledges the receipt of your letter dated June 24, 1992, by which you transmitted Revision 13 to the Waterford-3 Physical Security Plan for your facility.

We find the changes in the subject letter and the attachments thereto to be consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p) with the following exceptions:

- The phrase "as required" that was added should be deleted from the first sentence of Section 2.4.8.5, "Patrols." This phrase allows discretion by the licensee and, therefore, is considered to lessen the plan's commitment.
- The phrase "under normal operations" that was added to Section 3.2.3.1, "Access Control Facility"; Section 3.2.4, "Doors and Personnel Access Portals"; and Section 5.6.1.1, "Frotected Area Access Points" should be deleted since the fourth paragraph on page 1 adequately addresses normal and emergency conditions that may require changes to the security measures committed to in the plan.
- The commitment to have the central alarm station operator conduct communications tests was changed to a commitment of having a communications test completed. It is suggested that specific positions or locations be identified in the plan to remain consistent with your identified locations that maintain offsite communications capability.
- The term "Plant Controlled Area" in Appendix A, "Terms and Definitions" is a term that is not used anywhere in the Physical Security Plan. It appears that the definition more appropriately would fit the term Plant Protected Area. This would also be more consistent with all other licensee plans and NRC rules, regulations, and guidance.

The above matters were discussed during a phone conversation between Mr. Haase and Mr. Fields of your staff and Mr. Dexter of this office on August 28 and September 4, 1992. It is our understanding that changes to these items will

be included in your next plan revision. Your other changes are acceptable for inclusion into the plan.

The enclosures to your letter contain Safeguards Information of a type specified in 10 CFR 73.21 and are being withheld from public disclosure.


