Gentlemen:

This letter is in response to your letters dated April 17 and May 9, 1985, relating to fees for the following applications:

1. March 16, 1984 Application:

Your letter dated April 17, 1985 informed us that since only one regulation and one submittal is involved in your March 16, 1984 application in response to Generic Letters 82-16 and 83-37 and both letters address NUREG-0737 items, only the paid Class III and I fees are appropriate. Our letter to you dated February 20, 1985 requested additional fees (Class II and Class I) for the overtime requirements (GL-82-16). The March 16, 1984 application is subject to the fee provisions of 10 CFR 170.22 of the March 23, 1978 regulations which require fees according to the number and nature of the issues requiring review (i.e., single safety issue is a Class III, unrelated administrative issue is a Class II, several safety issues require a Class IV fee). NUREG-0737 is not the issue, but rather the basis for certain issues to be addressed by licensees. Consequently, we have determined that the fees previously requested are appropriate and due in the amount of \$1,600.

2. December 14, 1984 Application:

Your letter of May 9, 1985, informed us that the December 14, 1984 request relating to once-through SG sleeved tube inspection for ANO-1 does not require the requested \$150 application fee because it is covered by the \$150 application fee remitted with your August 13, 1984 application for Technical Specification changes for

SG surveillance. By Amendment No. 86 to License No. DPR-51, issued on November 8, 1984, the review of the August 13, 1984 application was completed and closed and review cost data is being collected to bill you for that application. Consequently, your submittal dated December 14, 1984, is considered a new request and its review and evaluation is required to determine the adequacy of the eddy current inspection techniques when inspecting sleeved tubes. On this basis, the \$150 application fee is due for your December 14, 1984 submittal in accordance with 10 CFR 170.12(c) and 170.21.A.

In conclusion, it is requested that your Company remit the sum of \$1,750 for fees currently required for your March 16 and December 14, 1984 requests.
