

Dear Mr. Brinkman:

As per Mr. McClintock's telecommunication of May 20 with Mr. R. Dubee, enclosed is an application for renewal of Byproduct Materials License 37-02006-06. We are taking this opportunity to expand our license into a broad license instead of renewing the license as it was. If this presents any difficulties or delays, please contact me at your convenience.

1. Section 4 - It is requested that the responsibility for evaluating, expanding, and maintaining the list of users and supervisors rest with the Ionizing Radiation Advisory Group. This group has been functioning effectively for over a year and its policies and procedures are contained in the attached Mandatory Safety Procedure M-6 (Attachment 7).
2. Section 6 - Item F (Hydrogen-3, 100 Ci) has been transferred from license 37-02006-05 (attached memo dated February 20, 1967 from C. Coner ( Attachment 8).
3. Section 5 - The Radiation Protection Officer has been changed from E. R. Harris to R. O. McClintock. His resume is attached.
4. Section 10 - This section was updated to include recent purchases.
5. Section 12 - The film badge service was changed from monthly to quarterly.
