On March 21, 1978, Licensee, MPCA and the NRC Staff filed a joint Motion for the withdrawal of MPCA's Contentions, the withdrawal of MPCA as a party to the proceeding and, absent objection by other parties, the dismissal of the proceeding.

After receipt of two extensions of time for the filing of an answer, Minnesota Environmental Control Citizens Association, E. Taylor Hare and Russell J. Hatling (collectively, MECCA), and Steve J. Gadler, have advised the Board by letter dated May 31, 1978, that it is their decision to continue intervention in this proceeding. All of the parties request that the Board consider these matters at a prehearing conference.


