Centlepen:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Order for Modification at License for the Honticello Nuclear Generating Plant pertaining to your proposed Technical Specifications which were submitted pursuant to Section 50.46 and Appendix K of 10 GFR Part 50. The enclosed Safety Evaluation Report contains the bases for our action.

A copy of the Order is being filed with the Office of the Federal Register for publication. This Order is effective immediately.

Within 30 days after receipt of this letter, we request that you inform us of your submittal date for the reevaluation required by paragraph 1 of Section III of the Order.

You will note that the Order requires that a reanalysis in conformance with the Order must be submitted prior to the issuance of any license amendment authorizing a core reloading. This will apply to any request for reloading beyond the Cycle Four reload which is covered by the enclosed Safety Evaluation. Our letter of December 26, 1974, informed you that no further authorization was required for the reloading involved in Cycle Four. If you intend to request any further authorization for core reloading, you should assure that such submittel is provided at least 45 days prior to your schedule of initiation of operation following approval of such reloading. You should also note, that since your current enalysis was based upon your presently authorized fuel loading patterns, any modification of fuel design or core configuration which affects the basis for the analysis will require staff approval.
