On May 14, 1975, Minnesota Pollution Control Agency, one of the intervenors in this proceeding, filed additional contention C.1 concerning the Applicant's proposal for complying with the Commission's guides with respect to Anticipated Transients Without Scram (ATWS). The contention was admitted by Board order dated August 5, 1975. It is our understanding that compliance of the Monticello plant with WASH-1270 is still under review by the NRC Staff. We wish to be advised concerning the schedule for completing this review.

In addition, the parties are requested to advise the

Board when they will be prepared for further evidentiary hearings on the issues cutstanding in this proceeding.
