In accordance with the provisions of 10CFR 50.90 this report is presented as proposed revisions to the subject security plan which upgrade the plan and do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the plan.

Specific details concerning the changes are contained in Enclosures A and B. Enclosure B presents the required revisions to the security plan, specific paragraphs, sketch of the permanent revised perimeter plot plan (Figure III) and revised table of organization (Figure I).


