On May 18, 1970 CO: I received a copy of a letter (see enclosure) from Mr. R. O. McClintock, RSO for subject licensee, to DML. McClintock described an incident, which occurred on May 6, 1970, in which a one millicurie cadmium-109 sealed source was accidentally dropped, ruptured, and caused a localized spread of comtamination of approximately 10,000 dpm. He reported that the area was decomtaminated to background levels and the source was placed in a Radiological Service Company wasta drum. McClimteck's letter also stated that urine samples of the involved persons ware assayed for indications of possible intake.

On July 13, 1970 C. Comer telephomed McClistock and amquired about the results of the urinalyses. McClistock stated that Isotopes Incorporated reported that the urine samples from J. Buth and B. Pokol had shown no significant activity above background (1907+ 130 dpm/liter and 200 + 200 dpm/liter, respective-1y) .
