Gentlemen:

We have your letter of March 22, 1972 referring to the inspection conducted by Mr. Edgar Ashley of your office on February 29 and March 1, 1972.

Following is the disposition of items of non-compliance and other points listed in your letter:

Item No. 1 - Inventory report. We submitted a source inventory report to the Commission's Oak Ridge office on March 15, 1972. This report (copy attached) gave our thorium inventory as of June 30, 1971. We will submit the 1972 report after June 30 as directed.

Item No. 2 - Process change. We are revising the detailed process write-up which was part of the current license application. This revision will include process and other changes made since 1969. We expect to complete and submit this to the Commission by April 30, 1972.

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Regarding the name of the licensee on License No. STA-583, we are requesting the Division of Materials Licensing to change this name from American Potash & Chemical Corporation to Kerr-McGee Chemical Corp. A copy of this letter is attached.
