The following are my observations after our visit to Kerr-McGee on 10/18/79. I realize that some of the following are your and Oberg's ideas; they are included for completeness.

- 1. We need to do a spectral analysis on samples we now have.
- 2. We need to do direct and smear measurements on at least a bi-weekly basis.
- 3. We need to expedite obtaining air samplers so we can perform independent airborne measurements.
- We should place TLD's around the facility.
- 5. We should check, in about two weeks, to determine that the Chem-Nuclear operations supervisor is not only expediting work, but also cognizant of need to proceed safely.
- 6. We should review procedures before dust collectors are removed and be present during their removal.
- 7. We should visit the site once per week for a partial inspection.
