With regard to those licenses listed in the report's Emhibit A which were apparently never issued, we feel that this could well have been a clerical error in noting license numbers, rather than a violation of the regulations. Since this matter was not employed by the inspector during the inspection nor was it brought up in our letter, we feel that a matter of this sort could be more empeditiously handled and clarified during the next scheduled inspection rather than writing to the licensee at this late date.
