SUBJECT: ABC-R 18/5 - PETITION FOR AMENDMENT OF 10 CFR 40, "LICENSING OF SOURCE MATERIAL" FILED BY AMERICAN POTASH AND CHEMICAL CORPORATION

1. We informed your office on April 4, 1961, that at the Policy Meeting 98 on April 5 the Commission:

a. Found that the possession and use by the United States of source material in the materials described in paragraph 1 of ABC-R 18/5 are not of significance to the common defense and security and that such activities can be conducted without any unreasonable hazard to life or property.

b. Found that, since the amendment will relieve firms rather than impose restrictions under regulations currently in effect and will not adversely affect the public health and safety, general notice of proposed rule-making and public procedure thereon are unnecessary and good cause exists for making the amendment effective upon publication.

c. Approved the issuance of the amendment to 10 CFR 40 set out in Appendix "B", as revised, to ABC-R 18/5.

d. Noted that the amendment will be published in the Federal Register, to become effective upon publication.

e. Noted that a letter will be sent to American Potash and Chemical Corporation, substantiating the action taken as Appendix "C" to ABC-R 18/5.

f. Noted that the Director of the National Atomic Energy Commission will be informed of this action by letter such as Appendix "D" to ABC-R 18/5.

2. The Commission requested paragraph 2 of the Notice of Rule
making be revised so as to read:

"On March 1, 1961, American Bosch and Chemical Corporation
filed a petition with the Commission requesting the re-
vocation of this exemption. In its petition the
Corporation described, among other things, the industrial
processes and commercial products in which such new earth
chemicals are used, and the absence of justification for
licensing from the standpoint of the health and safety of
the public."
