License No. 12-4932-1 was inspected concurrently with License No. R-234.

A discussion of the licensee's control and administrative program for the use of radioactive material is presented in the full report on R-234. Information specific for the material possessed under 12-4932-1 is included in these notes.

Under license No. 12-4932-1, this licensee possesses in storage 10 millicuries of Yttrium 91 (as of 3-13-61) and 1 millicurie of Iron 55 (as of 11-6-59). Dr. Robert M. Healy, the individual user named on this license, stated that the programs for which this radioactive material had been procured, had failed to materialize. He stated that he is reluctant to dispose of these materials since he may at some time in the future, desire to utilize them.

With regard to procurement of radioactive materials under License No. 12-4932-1, Dr. Healy stated that the procurement of the isotopes had been done directly by him, and that he personally will use or be physically present for the use of these materials. He has exercised control of the procurement.

That material possessed under Byproduct Material License No. 12-4932-1 is stored at The Research Development Laboratory, West Washington & Wood Streets, West Chicago, Illinois. Storage is accomplished within a chemistry laboratory on a storage shelf. The containers of radioactive material are labeled to show in magenta on yellow the conventional symbol
