2. The survey to indicate that the old Radiopharmacy (Room W2U3) is free from Radioisotope contamination showed the following results:

Wipe Tests

Results

(1) Bench Top near Sink	Less than .005 microcuries
(2) Bench Top near L-shield	Less than .005 microcuries
(3) Sink Top	Less than .005 microcuries
(4) Floor at Sink	Less than .005 microcuries
(5) Floor at Work Area	Less than .005 microcuries
(6) Floor at Outside Entry Door	Less than .005 microcuries
(7) Door Knob	Less than .005 microcuries

3. Based on results above we conclude that the old Radiopharmacy Room W2U3 is safe for use as an unrestricted area.

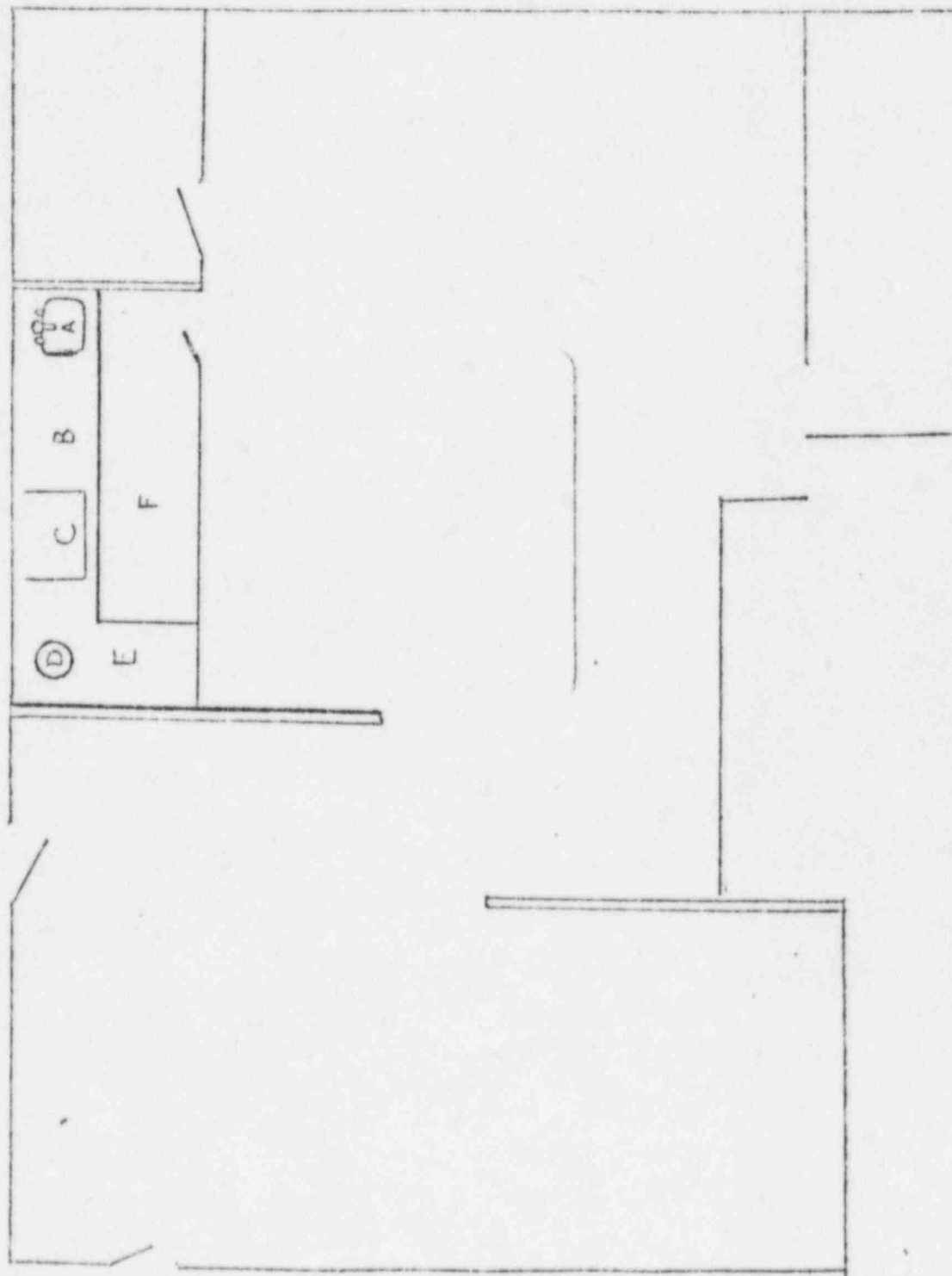
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FLOOR PLAN NUCLEAR MEDICINE "HOT" ROOM
