
Pursuant to New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission Regulations, enclosed, you are hereby notified that a discharge plan as defined in Section 1-101.P. is required for your proposed uranium mill tailings remedial action project to be located at Ambrosia Lake in McKinley County, New Mexico.

This notification of discharge plan requirement is pursuant to Sections 3-104 and 3-106 of the regulations.

Please be advised that any discharge from this facility without prior approval from EID would be in violation of the regulations. Before discharging you must have either a discharge plan approved by EID or temporary permission to discharge without an approved discharge plan. Temporary permission can only be granted for good cause shown by you and can only be for a nonrenewable period of not more than 120 days.

Enclosed for your convenience are a discharge plan application form/outline and a brief description of discharge plan procedures.
