Please find with this cover letter a check in the amount of \$5,300.00 to cover the application fee for the modification/issuance of a new NRC License to cover the additional requirements as outlined below. The original license XCOM 1027 was issued on December 23, 1992 (copy attached) for Zircaloy alloy welded shroud tube assemblies, test spools and Hafnium control rod drive tubes. Through our customer, Siemens/KWU in Germany we have been asked to quote on an additional scope of work which includes shipping additional zircaloy tubes not originally contemplated in the original license.


