The City of Stillwater, Oklahoma in 1979 began application process to obtain a license from the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in order to maintain and use a nuclear density machine in order to improve subgrades we were getting under our paving.

City Staff was trained in the use of this machine and in the hazards of nuclear radiation. We were all certified to operate the equipment and made application to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in December of 1979 to become licensed in order for us to purchase a machine.

The City of Stillwater war finally licensed on February 28, 1980, so that we could obtain and the a density machine. Since that time, we have been filing our response eports with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission. Recently we have been some an anowed with letters from Mr. Stello concerning overdue personnel monitoring reports for the years 1978 and 1979. These letters have been sent out on form letter format with no specific addressee. Our reaction has been to file these in the waste basket because we were not even licensed in 1978 and 1979. They continued to send us these reports even threatening to take away our license if we did not respond. Therefore, after many man hours of time wasted on Nuclear Regulatory Commission paperwork, we have finally checked personnel monitoring not required in the years requested and mailed the paper work back.

I have attached the letter that we received from the Federal Government as well as the paperwork that we finally returned to them.

I would request your review of this and consideration on this type of burdening paperwork required by some of the agencies over which you have supervision. I do appreciate your time and interest in this matter.

OVERDUE PERSONNEL MONITORING REPORTS

Amendments to \$20.407, 10 CFR Part 20, published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on September 29, 1978 (43 FR 44827) required all NRC specific licensees to report, in statistical summary form, the results of personnel monitoring for each of the years 1978 and 1979. The reports were due March 31 in 1979 and 1980, respectively. Copies of the amendments were sent to all NRC licensees by letter dated October 10, 1978 (copy enclosed). Subsequent reminder letters were sent on January 29, 1979 and November 30, 1979.

As of this date we have not received a report of your monitoring results for 1979 that can be identified with the NRC icense number(s) that appear(s) in the upper corner of the address label on this letter.

We recognize that there are several circumstances which could result in our failure to identify the referenced license number(s) with a report that you might have submitted. Some of these circumstances are shown on the enclosed "Potential Reasons for Failure to Identify Submitted Reports." If you believe this to be your case, you should advise us of the circumstances involved with enough additional information to clearly identify the license number(s) and to complete the report.

You may use the enclosed suggested format to file your report(s). Note that, if you were not required to provide personnel monitoring equipment to assess any individual's radiation dose during 1979, you only need to check the box on the suggested format and return the format to the Director of Management and Program Analysis, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, D.C. 20555. Questions may be directed to the Licensee Operations Evaluations Branch, Office of Management and Program Analysis, 301-492-4978.

Your immediate attention to this matter is expected. Failure to file the report(s) constitutes non-compliance with the regulations in 10 CFR Part 20.
