Florida Power Corporation (FPC) has reviewed your letter of August 26, 1985 in which you requested that we provide additional information on the above subject.

The B&W Owners Group is meeting this week to determine in greater detail the method for measuring the gap between the reactor trip breaker armature and rivet, the accepted method for measuring the breaker insulation resistance, and the details for conjecting and analyzing data for breaker maintenance trending analysis reporting.

Therefore, FPC will respond to your request for additional information on or before October 11, 1985. By extending this submittal date, FPC can provide a more complete response without the need for additional responses.
