This letter is a follow-up to my telephone request of December 2, 1996, which I left on your voice mail.

As you know, Massachusetts has set fees for NARM licensees and these fees will increase for NRC licensees once the Agreement is signed. However, as I am sure you also know, we originally set our fees based upon 1993 information concerning existing NRC licenses. Based upon our recent telephone conversations, and the new information that we have received concerning NRC's updated computer-based billing process, we need to readjust our fees for the upcoming years. This being the case, could you please obtain for me (or tell me who to contact to obtain) a completed listing of all NRC Massachusetts licenses, and the associated fees charged and collected from these licenses for your fiscal years 1994, 1995, and 1996. Additionally, it would be really helpful if I could get a listing of your Fiscal 1997 billing amounts by facility and by month.
