Steam Generator Slewing Program
Occupational Dose Estimate

As previously discussed, Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (NNECO) hereby provides the following information in response to the Staff's request.

Item 1: Provide a table showing the collective occupational dose estimate for the Steam Generator Slewing program. Include all occupational dose resulting from slewing operations, including all site and contractor support personnel. This information should include a breakdown of each task by estimated dose rates, person-hours, and person-rem. The data should be in sufficient detail to permit unambiguous calculation of the project person-rem doses likely to result. Include all manpower and operations resulting from the proposed slewing program.

Response to Item 1:

Since these jobs are complete, the actual man-rem exposures and person-hours are as follows:


Response to Item 2:
