Gentlemen:

This confirms the telephone conversation on May 30, 1972, with Nr. Cecil R. Buchsnan concerning the Kerr-McGee Corporation's application for amendment to License No. SUB-1010 to dispose of liquid wastes from its uranium hexafluoride production plant by deep-wall injection.

As a matter of background, in November 1969, a similar proposal from Kerr-HoGee was transmitted through the Commission's Division of Reactor Development and Technology to the Office of Radiohydrology for review and comments. Subsequently, Mr. Robert Schneider responded to our request in letters dated November 19, 1969 and July 13, 1970. On October 15, 1970, we denied Kerr-McGee's initial request for liquid waste disposal by deep-well injection and the company was given an opportunity to request a hearing on the matter. In lieu of a hearing, Kerr-McGee requested withdrawal of its application without prejudice to resubmission of another application. The request was approved.

We are enclosing a copy of Earr-NeGee's letter dated May 10, 1972, resubmitting its request for approval of deep-well injection as a means of waste disposal. This request is supported by enclosures which represent purported bydrological and geological tests and studies. We would appreciate
