Assessment of Allegation: The implied significance of this allegation is that traceability of materials may have been lost, thus causing the validity of the installed material containing the required certification to be questionable.

In assessing this allegation the NRC staff reviewed Mercury weld data reports and took random samples of filler material heat numbers for verification of their traceability to Certified Material Test Reports (CMTRs). Procurement Purchase Orders and CMTRs were also reviewed for heat numbers sampled and were found to be acceptable.

In addition, the staff reviewed six operational control record (OCR) packages which contained weld records for 28 different instrument lines. No evidence of adding of falsifying heat numbers was found in these. However, many of the first issue (pink sheets) Mercury weld records were a combination of photocopy and original (pen and ink) data. Thus the original documents in most cases were not available for review.

In conclusion, this allegation has neither safety significance nor generic implications. However, the NRC Office of Investigations is also pursuing this allegation.
