

Simulator Requalification Training

Gentlemen:

As discussed in a telephone conversation between Mr. Ralph Cooley of NRC Region IV headquarters and Mr. James Constantin, ANO-2 Operations Training Supervisor, AP&L requests a waiver on the Unit-2 annual simulator training for Shift Technical Advisors for the 1985 requalification training year. AP&L had originally planned to complete this training using the ANO-2 simulator, however, due to construction delays it does not appear that the ANO-2 simulator will be certified ready for training until late in the fourth quarter of 1985. Because of its scheduled late availability date, we are requesting this one time waiver.

When the ANO-2 simulator is certified the simulator training for Shift Technical Advisors will be conducted. Requalification simulator training for Shift Technical Advisors will be completed for the 1986 requalification year by December 31, 1986 and will resume annually to coincide with the requalification training year requirements.
