With regard to Mr. R. D. Walker's (NRC/OIE) May 21, 1984 letter providing the NRC's evaluation of Duke's response to the referenced inspection report's notice of violation (Ref. my letter to you dated April 11, 1985), the following information is submitted pursuant to 10 CFR 2.201(a) for violation 50-370/85-05-02 as requested.

1. Steps which have been taken to correct the violation and the results achieved:

Duke Power Company does not agree with the violation. The materials were used in accordance with governing procedures, station directives and the manufacturers precautions, and consequencly adequate control of materials was maintained.

Duke does not consider that a hazard existed. Further, in accordance with the Housekeeping Inspection Program all plant areas are periodically reins, acted against applicable criteria to verify compliance with standards and station directives.

Corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violation:

All penetrant materials have been removed from the upper head injection nitrogen and water accumulator area.

> All non-destructive examination (NDE) Personnel have been instructed to inventory materials prior to use in the plant and upon their return. All plant areas will continue to be inspected for housekeeping according to the established schedule.
