## I. BACKGROUND

The licensee submitted a complete copy of the REP which incorporated Revision 17, dated May 20, 1985.

Most of the revisions were concerned with general changes. For example, the Radiological Support Office of the CMC was changed to the Nuclear Technical Services Office and the Tech. Support Office became the Nuclear Engineering Office. These and other such changes were made throughout the REP. Revisions like the above were determined to neither increase nor decrease the plan effectivenss.

## III. SUMMARY AND CONCLUSION

Based on the review of Revision 17 of the McGuire Nuclear Station REP, the revisions and changes to the REP, appear to meet the requirements of  $10~\rm CFR~50.54(q)$  in that the changes did not decrease the effectiveness of the plan, and the standards of  $10~\rm CFR~50.47(b)$  continue to be met. NRC's response to the license should reflect that these requirements are met.
