This will confirm our telephone conversation of last week at which time I advised you of the agreement reached with the Mallinckrodt Chemical Works for them to acquire Nuclear Consultants Corporation. The agreement was signed November 30, 1965 and will be closed and the transfer take place on January 5, 1966.

I have requested that an officer of Mallinckrodt officially notify you of this acquisition and request transfer of our license Nos. 24-4206-1 (J66), 12-11393-1 (K67), and 34-6789-1 (I66) covering St. Louis, Chicago and Cleveland, effective January 5, 1966.

As I am sure they will outline, we will continue to operate with the same personnel, health physics program, in the same facilities after the acquisition, as we have in the past.
