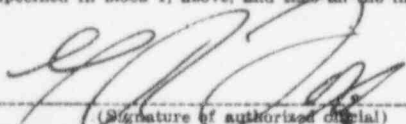

Before further action may be taken regarding issuance of a license authorizing the export of uranium to your customer in Mexico it will be necessary that we be furnished a current statement by an official of the Ministry of Health in Mexico City, Mexico. Such a statement should certify that the Ministry of Health is aware of the proposed use of uranium in wine by Laboratorios Rosavilla S.A., Churubusco, Coyoacan, D.F., Mexico, for medicinal purposes and has no objection to the import by that company of uranium nitrate for that purpose.

Prompt action will be taken on your application upon receipt of this additional information.
