Dear Mr. Johnson:

Source Material License R-160 of March 23, 1955 authorized us to receive up to three thousand pounds of Euxenite Concentrate from Porter Bros. The license also required us to report our inventory of source material acquired and produced during the term of the license.

As of April 1, 1956, we had received 2,731 pounds of Euxenite Concentrate from Porter Bros. This contained 183.15 pounds of Uranium Oxide (U_3O_8). Of this figure we had put into process on April 1st, 140.6 pounds. The remainder had not yet been put into process.

As of April 1, 1956, no shipments of Euxenite Concentrate or the Uranium Oxide mentioned above had been made. We plan to transfer all of this material to our regular Euxenite plant which we are operating as a Sub-Contractor under A. E. C. Contract AT(49-6)-985 with Porter Bros. Corporation of Boise, Idaho.

It is our understanding that this notification fulfills and terminates License R-160 referred to above.
