Subject: PROPOSED REVISION TO THE PHYSICAL SECURITY PLAN

On August 29, 1985, members of the Region II staff and representatives of Carolina Power and Light Company (CP&L) met to discuss proposed changes to the H. B. Robinson Physical Security Plan (PSP). The changes involve integration of a major security upgrade modification with the existing electronic intrusion detection/access control system. The licensee has developed Chapter 9 of the PSP which desribes the modifications and the phased integration of the systems. The licensee's proposal was discussed and no major conflicts were identified. Editorial clarification was suggested to enhance the clarity and inspectability of the proposed changes during system change over. Another change was discussed which involved the reconfiguration of a vital area barrier. The change does not involve the redesignation of any vital equipment.
