Dear Mr. Youngblood:

This letter is provided in response to your letter dated August 26, 1985 concerning the safety classification of the Transverse Incore Probe (TIP) and Subsystem.

The TIP piping and subsystems are safety classified and, as noted in Table 3.2-1, are Quality Group B. We regret that FSAR Table 3.2-1 was erroneously changed to show a non-safety classification "NSR". The safety classification of the TIP piping/subsystems will be changed to safety class 2 in the next amendment to the FSAR.
