Dear Dr. Bartolome:

This is to respond to a letter received from Mr. Gabriel Santos, Jr., requesting seismic information submitted to NRC by the license applicant for the Diablo Canyon nuclear power plant.

Please inform Mr. Santos that I have encountered several problems in collecting the requested information. First, the seismic information submitted to NRC in the PSAR and FSAR was not in a format consistent with the present format of NUREG-0800 and therefore to obtain information regarding vibratory ground motion and surface faulting would require a geologist's detailed review of the PSAR and FSAR and obtaining the information from several sections. Second, seismic issues related to the Diablo Canyon license application have been the subject of many meetings during the licensing review and hearing process and a great volume of correspondence and reports exist. The requested information would have to be separated out of the above cited information.

NRC makes the following suggestion for Mr. Santos. Regulatory Guide 1.70 describes the format and contents of the Safety Analysis Report (SAR). The Standard Review Plan describes how NRC staff will review the SAR. If Mr. Santos, after a review of the pertinent sections of each of these documents, has specific questions related to vibratory ground motion or surface faulting, I shall try to obtain answers to his questions.
