Dear Mayor Morris:

Prior to our June 20, 1985 meeting here in Washington, D.C., our TMI Program Office provided the Panel with an NRC staff paper that contained an overview of all studies associated with radiation releases during the TMI-2 accident undertaken to date. The paper also included staff recommendations as to whether further studies should be done.

During the meeting, the Commission asked for the Panel's view on this paper before making a decision. The Panel indicated it would not be appropriate for them to comment.

Subsequent to the meeting, the Commission reviewed the staff's analysis in the paper and concurs in the staff's recommendation that there is no need for any additional studies on TMI-related health effects other than those studies which are already planned or underway.
