In your E-mail, you reiterated your request that the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS) units be shutdown and the spent fuel removed immediately based on your concerns regarding the seismic adequacy of the SONGS units. For the reasons stated in Mr. Miraglia's letter to you dated February 6, 1997, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff is temporarily suspending its review of your petition, until such time as you have provided all the information you wish to be considered in the staff's final decision regarding your petition.
