Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. R. C. Stewart and other members of our staff during the period May 10-13, 1977, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit Nos. CPPR-126 and 127 for the Comanche Peak facility, Units No. 1 and 2, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. L. F. Fikar and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

Within the scope of the inspection, no items of noncompliance were identified.

We have also examined actions you have taken with regard to previously identified enforcement matters and unresolved items. The status of these items is identified in paragraphs 2 and 5 of the enclosed report.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.
