EXERCISE WEAKNESSES

- Utilization of the Post Accident Sampling System (PASS), as demonstrated by a two person team was unsatisfactory. The total time from when the team was dispatched until the sample results were obtained was approximately 5¹/₂ hours. Open Item No. 331/85016-01 (Section 4.c).
- One of the Offsite Radiological Monitoring Teams (RMTs) lost communications with the Emergency Operations Facility (EOF) and the other RMT for approximately 1¹/₂ hours. Open Item No. 331/85016-02 (Section 4.f).
- One of the Offsite Radiological Monitoring Teams failed to follow EPIPs 2.6 and 3.2 in the collection, packaging, and identification of soil, water, and vegetation samples. Open Item No. 331/85016-03 (Section 4.f).
