- Procurement by negotiation of the above described services is necessary because solicitation of technical proposals specifying the skills, knowledge, experience and technical approach of the offerors is required in order to determine which offerors are technically qualified to perform the work and which offeror to select for award.

Use of formal advertising for procurement of the above described services is impracticable because it is not possible to draft, for the solicitation of bids, specifications which adequately describe the work to be accomplished. Only the ultimate objectives and general scope of work is known at this time.
