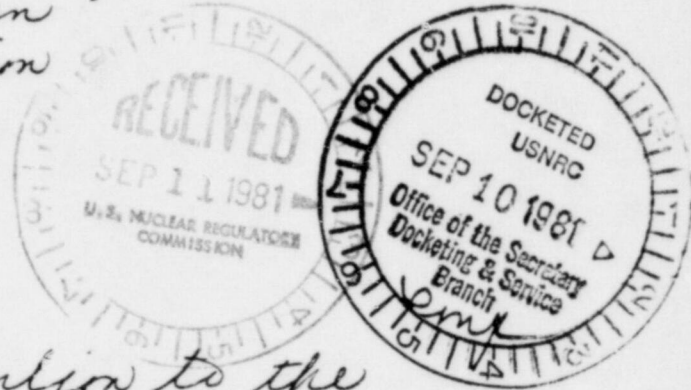

Dear Chairman Palladino:

Please turn your attention to the request of the N. Y. Public Interest Research Group (NY PIRG) calling for the shut-down of the nuclear reactors at Indian Point, N. Y. within 50 miles of these reactors about one-tenth of the U. S. population resides and yet there is no formal evacuation plan established. There is also a question about the plants' safety, considering that the metal of the reactor pressure vessel could become dangerously brittle.

I wish to encourage your commission to close down Indian Point. I feel that as a resident of the mid-Hudson Valley my family's safety is in jeopardy. Thank you.
