APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT
TO OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to Section 50.90 of the regulations of the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the "Commission"), Duquesne Light Company ("DLC"), holder of Operating License No. DPR-66, hereby requests that the Technical Specifications set forth in Appendix A to that license be amended to clarify the Mode 5 and 6 charging pump surveillance requirements, to correct the Modes in Which Surveillance is Required for the High Steamline Pressure Rate instrumentation for Steamline Isolation and to replace the term "Operational Condition 1" with the term "Mode 1".

The proposed technical specification change is set forth in Attachment A to this Application. A no significant hazard evaluation is set forth in Attachment B. Based on the guidance provided by the Commission, the proposed changes have been determined to involve no significant hazards consideration in accordance with 10 CFR 50.92.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that Appendix A to Operating License No. DPR-66 be amended in the form attached hereto as Attachment A.
