was hired. Constable provided a memo regarding this matter which is appended as Enclosure (1).

On August 3, 1982, Mr. Robert Fortman, Assistant Area Supervisor, Department of Labor, Fort Worth, Texas, telephonically notified the reporting investigator that, on August 3, 1982, filed a complaint against TBI for discrimination. Mr. Fortman stated he accepted the complaint and it would be forwarded to the DOL New Orleans, Louisiana, office for investigation.
- 4. Or August 16, 1982, Mr. Jim Sylvester, DOL, New Orleans, Louisiana, teletrorically advised the reporting investigator that he was in receipt of the complaint and was preparing to initiate an investigation of the matter, as per Enclosure (2). Mr. Sylvester was advised that since the complaint did not include any alleged violations of matters within the NKL jurisdiction that no concurrent NRC investigation is planned at this time.
