On February 1, 1983, Les CONSTABLE, NRC Resident Reactor Inspector at Waterford-3, was contacted by reporting investigator in order to arrange an available work space at Waterford-3 regarding the initiation of this investigation. At this time, CONSTABLE advised that the allegation has been resolved and had been fired on or about CONSTABLE also stated that the alleger had resigned for personal reasons in September 1982. CONSTABLE indicated that there was correspondence to this effect, and stated he would attempt to locate the proper correspondence to confirm these actions.
