

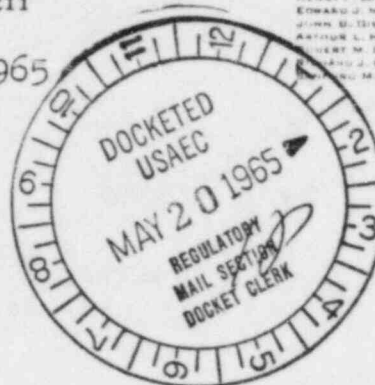

Dear Doctor Doan:

The Federal Register of April 24, 1965, contains the notice of proposed issuance of amendment to provisional operating license No. DPR-7 to permit operation of the reactor at power levels up to 240 megawatts (thermal). The notice provides that if no request for hearing or petition for leave to intervene is filed the Commission will issue the license amendment thirty days from the date of publication in the Federal Register.

This letter is to request that you advise me by collect telegram as soon as possible after the amendment has been issued and that you so notify NELIA at the same time. We have instructed NELIA to advise you in turn that they are furnishing the revised amount of financial protection required, which we calculate to be \$43,200,000.
