## Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. H. S. North of this office on October 14-17 and 30, 1975 of activities authorized by NRC License No. DPR-7 and to the discussion of our findings held by Mr. North with Mr. Raymond and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that one of your activities was not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. This item of noncompliance has been categorized into a level as described in our correspondence to you dated December 31, 1974. The item identified in the attached Notice of Violation was reported in a letter dated August 8, 1975, as required by Section 20.405 of the NRC's "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. The actions to be taken to prevent recurrence which were specified in the letter were verified during the inspection. No reply to the Notice of Violation is required.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you submit a written application

The application must include a full statement of the reasons why it is claimed that the information is proprietary. The application should be prepared so that any proprietary information identified is contained in an enclosure to the application, since the application without the enclosure will also be placed in the Public Document Room. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified period, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
